A RESOLUTION OF  
THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS,  
DEDICATING LOST CREEK PARKWAY  
TO THE HONOR AND MEMORY OF  
SERGEANT KEVIN GUY TRAMMELL,  
BADGE NUMBER 306;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor of City of Fairfield Bay on or about April 2, 2023, issued a Proclamation dedicating Lost Creek Parkway to the Honor and Memory of Sergeant Kevin Guy Trammell; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant Kevin Guy Trammell began working for the Fairfield Bay Police Department on September 11, 2020, and passed away on June 30, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant Trammell, Badge Number 306, honorably served the citizens of Fairfield Bay with loyalty, dedication, and courage for two years; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant Trammell received a Purple Heart for injuries received in the line of duty, the Police Excellence ribbon for his ability to treat each person with respect and dignity, the Public Service commendation for his community service, both on and off duty, and the Distinguished Silver Star for risking his life in the line of duty, on multiple occasions; and

**WHEREAS**, He was born in Springfield, Arkansas, on August 4, 1970, graduated from Timbo High School, Timbo, Arkansas, and studied at Ozarka College in Melbourne, Arkansas; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant Trammell worked in law enforcement for twenty-three years. He previously served as Deputy Sheriff in Searcy County, and as Chief of Police in the City of Marshall, among other positions. He also served as a member of the Army National Guard; and

**WHEREAS**, He was also involved with his family, and his community, in many ways. He was Vice-President for the Arkansas Chapter of the Punishers Motorcycle Club, a group of law enforcement officers, firefighters, and emergency medical support personnel, known for their love of riding together, reaching out through events involving family, and helping their communities and those in need, sometimes called a brotherhood of community service, priding themselves on involvement with their families; and

**WHEREAS,** The Chief of Police for the City of Fairfield Bay officially retired Sergeant Trammell's Badge Number 306; and

**WHEREAS,** Sergeant Trammell, Badge 306, served his community and fellow officers with pride, bravery, and dedication; the City Council and the Mayor wish that he rest peacefully knowing that he is greatly loved, and will never be forgotten;

**WHEREAS,** the City Council, and the Mayor, want to memorialize the Mayor's dedication of Lost Creek Parkway in the permanent records of the City of Fairfield Bay, Arkansas;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby RATIFIES, CONFIRMS, AND APPROVES the Mayor's April 2, 2023, Proclamation that Lost Creek Parkway Shall Be Dedicated To The Honor And Memory Of Sergeant Kevin Guy Trammell, Badge 306.


SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Recorder-Treasurer, be, and they are hereby, AUTHORIZED AND APPROVED to take any and all additional actions as may be necessary to memorialize and record the City's dedication of Lost Creek Parkway to the honor and memory of Kevin Guy Trammell, Badge 306.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately. The Recorder-Treasurer shall post this Resolution and publish it by newspaper in accordance with the City's regular publication requirements.
