

RESOLUTION NO. 2023- 15

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY,
ARKANSAS, APPROVING
DISPOSITION OF ASSETS;
APPROVING REMOVAL OF
CERTAIN ASSETS
FROM CITY'S LIST OF ASSETS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Fairfield Bay has received a request from the Recorder-Treasurer to update the City's Records, consistent with the City's responsibilities; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully considered the requests, and, having discussed it at a Regular Session of the City Council, approves the request;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS, that:

1. The Thunderbird Mixer from the Senior Center, asset no. 32, does not run, is obsolete, is inoperable, and is no longer being used by the Senior Center.
2. The two EcoClean Cubes used for recycling, asset no. 166, and located at the City Center (Lion's Club) and Woodland Mead Park, do not run, are obsolete, are inoperable, and are no longer being used by the City.
3. The 2022 Dodge Durango, asset no. 238, was involved in an accident in April 2023, does not run, is obsolete, is inoperable, and can no longer be used by the Police Department after the insurance company totaled the vehicle.


4. The "Zero Radius" Mower, asset no. 129, previously used by the Street Department to cut the grass, was traded in for a new mower, and was given a value of \$800.00 by the dealer on the trade-in.
5. The City Council hereby approves the disposition of the Zero Radius Mower by trade-in for a new mower.
6. The other three assets appear to have little to no retail value, or a value of less than \$100.00; the City Council hereby approves disposition of these assets by the City in the most economical manner possible as authorized by state law, including by sending them to the dump. The Recorder-Treasurer shall retain a statement or indication of the manner of disposition of the other three assets, and the value obtained, if any (such as "for scrap").
7. The City shall remove the following assets from its list of assets:
 - i. Thunderbird Mixer, serial number 800377.
 - ii. Ecoclean Cubes (two).
 - iii. Dodge Durango vehicle, with VIN ending in 36622.
 - iv. Zero Radius Mower, serial number ending in 36394.
8. The Mayor, and the Recorder-Treasurer, are further authorized to take any and all steps necessary to carry out this Resolution, including transferring title to vehicles.
