ORDINANCE NO. 2024-39

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE
CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS,
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2024-30
CONCERNING MUNICIPAL CODE
CHAPTER 3.04 – PURCHASES;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, The City Council concludes that the Acting Mayor needs emergency spending authority in the event of inclement weather or other issues that may arise; and

WHEREAS, The City Council now sets aside the temporary change to Chapter 3.04 of the Municipal Code, concerning fiscal affairs, which passed the Council on November 6, 2024, and which went into effect without the approval of the Mayor;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS:


1. NOT TO BE CODIFIED: That Ordinance No. 2024-30, amending Chapter 3.04 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fairfield Bay on a temporary basis, be, and it is hereby, REPEALED.
2. NOT TO BE CODIFIED: The Mayor and the Recorder-Treasurer be, and they are hereby, AUTHORIZED AND APPROVED TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS, INDEPENDENTLY, NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS ORDINANCE IN A TIMELY MANNER.

3. NOT TO BE CODIFIED: **EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is necessary for the efficient operation of Municipal Government that the City again authorize the Mayor's emergency spending authority; now, therefore, **AN EMERGENCY IS DECLARED TO EXIST**, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, as well as for the preservation of the City's fiscal integrity and the Mayor's ability to respond to any emergency, IT SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT: IMMEDIATELY UPON AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE.

4. NOT TO BE CODIFIED: **SEVERABILITY CLAUSE:** If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof, to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance, which shall be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.
