

RESOLUTION NO. 2026- 02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR
THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS,
AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FAIRFIELD BAY PARK
FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING
DECEMBER 31, 2026;
APPROPRIATING FUNDS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, The City Council has had on-going review of the City's anticipated expenditures during the current fiscal year, including compliance with the City's 2026 Budget Ordinances (as amended from time to time); and

WHEREAS, The City of Fairfield Bay currently has a budget for personnel at the Fairfield Bay Park (Campground), which will be obviated upon the recruitment of one additional "camp host" for the open season (which starts on April 1, 2026); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairfield Bay has made contractual arrangements for certain maintenance and upkeep, which further obviates the necessity of city personnel working at the Fairfield Bay Park; and

WHEREAS, The City needs additional funds for personnel in its Parks and Recreation budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS:

1. The City Council finds and determines that there is no need for personnel (payroll tax and salaries) in the City's operating budget for the Fairfield Bay Park (Campground). The City Council finds and determines that these personnel funds are needed in the Parks and Recreation budget.

2. The Mayor, and the Recorder-Treasurer, be, and they are hereby, AUTHORIZED AND APPROVED to remove funds from the "payroll tax and salaries" expenses (lines 6850 and 6010 (sic)) in the Campground budget, and to move those funds into (and as an addition to), the personnel expense item in the City's Parks and Recreation budget (line 6030 – including payroll tax and salaries). These changes should not have a fiscal impact on the City as there is no change in total expenditures resulting from this revision to the 2026 Budget (as amended).

3. The City Council hereby APPROPRIATES AND APPROVES additional expenditures not to exceed \$7,500.00 for payroll tax and salaries in the Parks and Recreation department, which funds are removed from the appropriation previously made in the


Campground budget. An amendment to the 2026 Budget Ordinances will be made separately, in accordance with the City's usual practice of amending the Budget by Ordinance at the end of the calendar year.

4. The Mayor, the Recorder-Treasurer, and the Parks and Recreation Department, be, and they are hereby, **AUTHORIZED TO TAKE** any and all appropriate actions necessary to put this Resolution into effect, in accordance with this Resolution, for the calendar year ending December 31, 2026.


5. This authorization, and appropriation, is effective immediately following its approval by the City Council, and the expenditures may take place as the Recorder-Treasurer shall decide. Posting and publication in the newspaper will take place according to the Recorder-Treasurer's normal schedule.
