

RESOLUTION NO. 2025- 41

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR
THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS,
AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF PAVING
FOR STREETS AND ROADS;
APPROVING BID IN EXCESS OF PREVIOUS ESTIMATE;
AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE STREETS AND ROADS
FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING
DECEMBER 31, 2025;
APPROPRIATING FUNDS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, The City Council has had on-going review of the City's anticipated expenditures during the current fiscal year, including compliance with the City's 2025 Budget Ordinance (as amended from time to time); and

WHEREAS, The City of Fairfield Bay currently needs paving on several different streets and roads, as a result of certain cul-de-sacs omitted from the 2024 paving of Snead Drive, and the deterioration of a section of West Cliff at 330, near the entrance to the campground and marina; and

WHEREAS, The City sought bids to pave these two areas, as authorized by Resolution No. 2025-35 (on September 8, 2025) based on an informal estimate of the amount needed (\$45,000.00); and

WHEREAS, The bid received came in slightly over the estimated cost of the project, but the City would like to go forward with the project at the amount bid (approximately \$52,000.00); and

WHEREAS, The City has determined that there are sufficient funds available to complete the project if the weather allows, in the current year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS:

1. The City Council finds and determines that paving the Snead Drive cul-de-sacs and the section of road at West Cliff and 330 needs to be paved in the most expeditious manner possible under the circumstances. Estimated costs for the projects were \$35,000.00 for the Snead Drive portion, and \$10,000.00 for the West Cliff-330 portion; the single bid received was for \$51,985.00.


2. The Mayor, and the Street Department specifically, be, and they are hereby, AUTHORIZED AND APPROVED to pave these streets and roads, after receipt of a single bid, within budgetary constraints, not to exceed \$52,000.00, for execution in the 2025 calendar year. This project does not need to be re-bid.

3. The City Council hereby APPROPRIATES AND APPROVES expenditures not to exceed \$52,000.00 for paving these streets and roads, from unappropriated reserve funds in the Street Department accounts. Resolution No. 2025-35, be, and it is hereby, amended, accordingly. An amendment to the 2025 Budget Ordinance will be made separately, in accordance with the City's usual practice of amending the Budget by Ordinance at the end of the calendar year.

4. The Mayor, the Recorder-Treasurer, and the Street Department, be, and they are hereby, AUTHORIZED TO TAKE any and all appropriate actions necessary to put this Resolution into effect, and have roads paved, in accordance with this Resolution, for the calendar year ending December 31, 2025.


5. This authorization, and appropriation, is effective immediately following its approval by the City Council, and the expenditures may take place as the Recorder-Treasurer shall decide. Posting and publication in the newspaper will take place according to the Recorder-Treasurer's normal schedule.
