

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-44

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY,  
ARKANSAS, AUTHORIZING  
DISPOSITION OF COMPUTER AT  
911 OPERATIONS CENTER;  
APPROVING REMOVAL OF  
COMPUTER AT 911 OPERATIONS CENTER  
FROM LIST OF ASSETS;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Fairfield Bay has received a request from the 911 Operations Center to approve the disposition of a computer, because it is past the end of its useful life, and is no longer useful for the 911 Operations Center (Dispatch), nor for the Department of Public Safety, and to remove it from the City's list of assets; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council has carefully considered the request, and, having discussed it at a Regular Session of the City Council, approves the request;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS, that:**

1. The Tower Work Station at the 911 Operations Center (Dispatch), at the Department of Public Safety, asset no. 176, originally purchased for \$1,249.00, has reached the end of its useful life, and is no longer being used by the Department of Public Safety, nor by the 911 Operations Center (Dispatch), nor by any other entity in the City of Fairfield Bay.
2. The fair market value of the 2017 Tower Work Station, is far less than \$20,000.00.

3. The City Council hereby approves the disposition of the 2017 Tower Work Station, by removing it from service and disposing of it in an appropriate manner to maintain confidentiality of 911 records. Ark. Code Ann. Section 14-54-302(b) and (c).
4. The City shall remove this asset from its list of assets, and the Department of Public Safety, and the 911 Operations Center (Dispatch) shall remove this asset from its list of assets (No. 176). The Mayor, Recorder-Treasurer, the Department of Public Safety, and the 911 Operations Center (Dispatch), are further authorized to take any and all steps necessary to carry out this Resolution, including disposing of the computer in a manner designed to protect confidential information that may be contained therein.
5. The City Council hereby ratifies, confirms, approves, and endorses any and all actions of the Department of Public Safety, the 911 Operations Center (Dispatch), the Mayor, and the Recorder-Treasurer, to date, to effectuate the disposition of this asset.


